BEFORE I TRUSTED CHRIST: "I was a violent, insolent person and did not want to hear anything anyone preached about Jesus and God. I did not believe in God's mercy because He allowed injustice of man to mankind."

HOW I TRUSTED CHRIST: "The second time I went to prison I was literally insane for two years. I was mad at God, the judge, the prosecutor, my lawyers, and myself for not knowing how I came to let myself be put in a position to where I was given a 35 year sentence. I felt it was unjustified so I was a raving mad lunatic, cussing and fighting for those two years.

"One day, Sunday, I was going to recreation, passing the gym where services were held. I heard what sounded like a choir in heaven singing. I passed on by but somehow found myself back at the door, looking in and listening to the heavenly sound. Suddenly I realized where I was standing and said, 'No! I ain't going in!' This happened three times and the third time the Spirit compelled me to go in. I made the altar call that day begging God to forgive me with tears pouring from my eyes. I was born again that day in January, 1995."

SINCE I HAVE TRUSTED CHRIST: "By God's grace I have weathered many trials and temptations, going through the 'tempering fire' so to speak. I know today that Satan is real. I know today that God Almighty is real and all-powerful, merciful, and righteous in all that He does. I do not hate anyone anymore, but I do hate the sin which defiles us. I now have compassion for all mankind, lifting them up in prayer for God's mercy. Even though I am back in prison as a mandatory supervision violator, God has used me to touch a number of men and state and county employees. I believe it is God's Spirit bearing witness with mine that I am His child."
