"The conversion all started when I was about to die of HIV. Because I already knew a bit about Christ, I begged him to help me. I didn't want to die without knowing him and alone in a jail. And my brothers, you who were already Christians, prayed with me and I asked the Lord to enter my heart and told him I wanted to serve him forever.

"And now it seems that everything is turning out well for me. I do my study with you and it seems that I will soon have the opportunity to be free. And even though I know I am sick, I feel healthy and happy because now Christ lives in me.
