During the first seven months of 2013 Write-Way honored 44 students who finished our curriculum. Their transcripts were forwarded to the Emmaus Correspondence School office (ECS) in Dubuque, IA for further studies. Also:

133 students completed 36 units of study.

97 students completed 48 units of study.

The graduates below have been transferred to ECS:

- 17 students completed 60 units of study.
- 71 students completed 72 units of study.
- 34 students completed 84 units of study.
- 21 students completed 96 units of study.
- 6 students completed 108 units of study.
- 1 student completed 120units of study.
