STEPHEN'S TESTIMONY From Navigator Book 2, Beginning a New Life:

BEFORE I TRUSTED CHRIST: "I was a sinner and I lusted, stole, and cheated like all sinners do. I used to think I couldn't enjoy life unless I was following the evil one and living in darkness. I hit rock bottom; I ran out of roads to travel on. My marriage of 15 years was falling apart." HOW I TRUSTED CHRIST: "While sitting in a one man cell in the county jail, God spoke to me through His Word, the Bible. I was amazed at all the knowledge that was in that book, and why I was too lazy to read it before my life fell apart. It took me two weeks to read the Bible." SINCE I TRUSTED CHRIST: "Since being here in this dorm [state prison], we've become a brotherhood through Christ. We all try to uplift each other, have daily Bible study, and prayer call too. It's our hope that what we have in our dorm, we hope to spread to other dorms by example. No more contraband, no more disrespecting the guards, no more fighting amongst ourselves. One of my new favorite verses comes from Luke 1:37: 'For nothing is impossible with God."
