Dear Friends,

Paul's instruction about a "laborer being worth his wages" (I Timothy 5:18) does not apply to us at WPM. We are <u>all volunteers!</u> However, Jesus' words concerning prayer for workers in the Harvest (Matthew 9:38) is most appropriate for WPM. This particular Harvest field in the prisons needs workers – workers who volunteer, workers who pray, and workers who give.

The history of WPM and its parent ministry, ECS, is to lay out the needs of the ministry and allow the Lord to direct His people in their support. In light of the various TV evangelists, that seems pretty laid back! The reason for our monthly posting of operating income and expenses is to inform our supporters.

Although you cannot see it on a black and white page, our red ink is serious. For 2014 year to date we are \$32,061 over budget. Generally we can depend on shortfalls early in the year to be covered by generous gifts at the end of the year. But we don't want to test the Lord and be presumptuous. Investment income of \$9,994 has been transferred to the operating account (Funds received),and we have borrowed \$15,000 from savings. A new roof at \$9,335 is the next expense.

WPM's unique work is pretty much still the best kept secret across the state. After 32 years I think the chaplains are aware of us. But our support base in the church community needs to be expanded and more clearly informed. Every past and current counselor in our Branches knows the exceptional value of this work, value to both the inmate and the worker. Would you spread the word?

In these perilous times our desire is to press on, expanding the outreach and bearing much fruit. Would you consider your part in such a vital, educational endeavor into our prisons? Thank you!
