The Year 2014 In Review

7,954: Growth of our Active Student body by 1,100 from 6,843 in January.

<u>79,028</u>: Courses our mailroom mailed out.

<u>53,359</u>: Exams our counselors have graded and prayed over.

<u>11,794</u>: New students who enrolled in 2014; some went home without their course, others transferred to another prison and left it behind, a few lost our courses, and some had them destroyed in shakedowns. Over the course of the year an average of 40% of the enrollees continue their studies.

<u>633</u>: First time professions of faith in Christ or about 53 per month.

<u>328</u>: Prison institutions housing our students – county/parish, state, and federal.

<u>124</u>: The number of students who graduated our English and Spanish curriculum.

<u>75%</u>: Postage (our largest expense) and course booklets account for $\frac{3}{4}$ of our total expenses.

The income stream was weak the first half of the year, but like most other ministries, ended with a vigorous increase by December 31.

<u>\$4.63</u>: The cost to completely service one student with one course, having the exam returned to the Branch for grading, and then the exam returned to the student with comments and other encouraging literature. This is an increase from \$4.16 in January.

<u>\$229,391.00</u>: Churches, Corporate grants, Local Independent Charities, and numerous individual gifts in 2014. <u>Thank you!</u>
