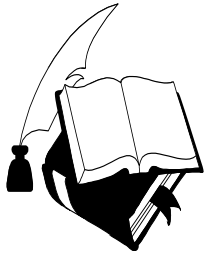

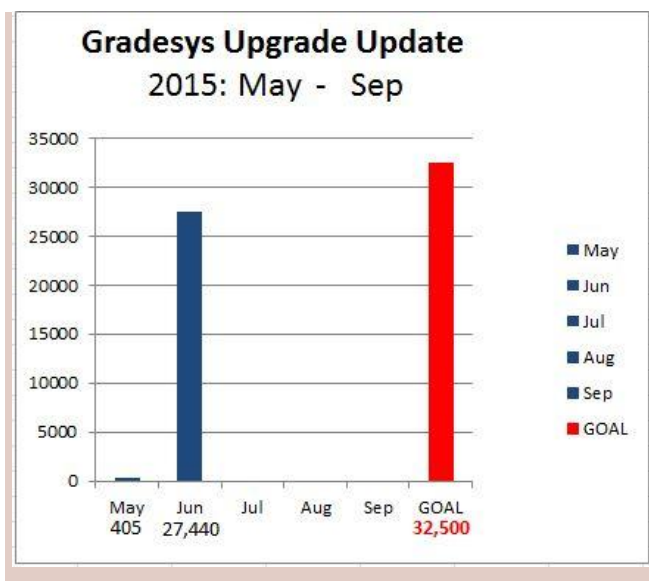

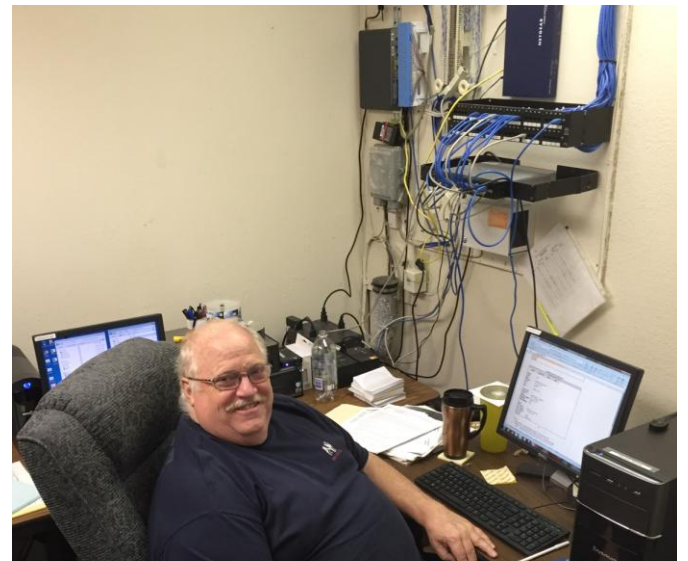
UPGRADE UPDATE

On two previous occasions WPM has had special campaigns - to fund a printer (2006) and last year the Navigator printing. Both were for \$10,000 and our friends and supporters gave more than enough in each case. When the Board reviewed our need for the database upgrade, it was obvious that it would be expensive. It was an act of faith to even publish the numbers in the May newsletter.

But within three weeks the Lord has graciously provided 84% of our goal! How does one comprehend that? Surely nothing is too hard for our Lord!
