GAVE ME CONFIDENCE

From Spanish Branch 80 Manager, Gaye Johns:

Every student gives us opportunity to share the Word of God, to offer words of encouragement and gentle correction. But some students give us a real white-water ride with their comments over the course of their confinement. Maria is such a student. She is free with her opinions. Out little team has laughed and cried and we have come together to pray for this woman.

Early on she shared that her jail time had something to do with trying to pass herself off as a man in order to marry. Her DUI was next, though it's not plain what the chronology was. Maria was furious that the police could not understand that she "had no choice but to drive" as several family members were on the way to another city for a funeral. She was oldest of several children, but her parents wanted a male. So they treated her as a male. Later, when her brother was born, they favored him. She hated her brother and "murdered" him with words.

Several months ago Maria's anger overflowed in a letter. She was denied parole. She was so angry she rushed back to her cell and broke her rosary into pieces. But Maria was so thankful for Como Vivir en Libertad (How to Succeed on the Street). Though she had been angry with God, He was always with her:

"I was far from Him, but I don't want to live that way any longer. Give me a hand and help me to walk correctly. I'm afraid of falling again. I want to learn to be responsible and hear His voice. I want to pray and give thanks in all my circumstances. This book gave me confidence that the Spirit will guide and direct me in being faithful, firm, and strong." Maria

It takes some people a long time to begin to "walk toward Jesus," but I'm so thankful so many do.
