In September, 1982, Ralph Nichols was asked to form a Texas prison ministry through Emmaus Correspondence School. Because Texas was such a large prison state, he wisely estimated he would need much assistance, and so the concept of "Branches" was formed – a group of volunteers at a local congregation who would grade and counsel with students from prisons assigned to them.

In 1983, Branch 002 was formed with Grace Hill as the manager. She went on to also form Branch 058 and Branch 059. In addition to working in the Garland office twice a week, she also taught a group of women weekly in the Collin County Jail.

After retiring in 2020, she set to work writing her memoirs as a hospice nurse. That book, entitled, <u>Dying with grace</u>, is now finished and published. I'll be deported to Mexico where the situation is really bad. I know I shouldn't be afraid or worried about it, for I am a child of God. He will fight for me, guide and provide for me as I am faithful to Him and His Word until He comes. He has certainly been great and marvelous to me in all the years I have been in this prison.
