Some interesting stats

Women's incarceration in USA county jails and state and federal prisons has gone from 26,326 in 1980 to 180,684 in 2022.

Basic necessities from commissaries for prisoners are greatly overpriced. .

The average prison wage tops out at \$0.52 per hour. A packet of Ramen noodles can be had at Walmart for about \$0.20. But prison commissaries charge as much as \$0.65. A prisoner would have to work 1.6 hours to afford one packet. Some examples are:

- 17.3 hours work to pay for reading glasses.
- 10.9 hours to pay for toothpaste.
- 7.1 hours to pay for soap.
- 2.8 hours to pay for a toothbrush.

Texas does not pay their prison workers at all, arguing that the labor of incarcerated people pays for their room and board. One Beaumont Federal prison has a contract with the government and pays working inmates about \$360 a month.

The opioid crisis in Dallas County is worsening. In 2018 fentanyl was responsible for 11.4% of all opioid-related deaths. By 2022 this figure had risen to 70.5%. The crisis is compounded by the fact that legal fentanyl is being mixed with other illicit substances.

What should I be doing?
